JANUARY 15, 2026, CLUB MEETING

The Optimist Club of Birmingham was honored to have Dr. Lashelle Barmore, with Archwell Health, as our guest speaker on January 15, 2026. Growing up in urban Alabama, Dr. Barmore saw the effects of diabetes on underserved communities firsthand. She came to ArchWell Health because of the care model, and believes it affords older patients the dignity and respect they deserve. Dr. Barmore shared some very helpful information on ways to keep a close watch on glucose levels with continuous monitoring devices that can even send data to your doctor.

Dr. Barmore received her undergraduate degree from Miles College in Fairfield, AL. She received her Doctorate of Osteopathic Medicine degree from Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences in Kansas City, MO. Dr. Barmore completed her residency with St. Vincent's East Family Residency Program in Birmingham, AL. She has been in private practice in the Birmingham area since 2012.

Dr. Barmore serves on the Junior Board of the Birmingham Chapter of the American Diabetes Association as well as the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. She is a member of the Alabama Medical Education Consortium, Alabama Osteopathic Medical Association, American Academy of Family Physicians, American Osteopathic Association, Alabama College of Osteopathic Medicine Preceptorship, American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians, Mineral District of Medical Society Medical Association of the State of Alabama (MASA), and the Impact Mentoring Executive Board.
